



2019 America's Farmers Grow Ag Leaders Scholarships Student Instructions



America's Farmers Grow Ag Leaders, sponsored by the Monsanto Fund, a philanthropic arm of Bayer, is giving students pursuing ag- related degrees the chance to earn a \$1,500 college scholarship. Grow Ag Leaders scholarships are administered by the National FFA Organization as part of the National FFA Scholarship Program.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

Students must:

- be high school seniors or enrolled in college.
- plan to pursue a degree or certification in specific areas of agriculture or chemical/electrical/mechanical engineering.

- have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- obtain two online farmer endorsements – visit AmericasFarmers.com for the complete requirements.

Students DO NOT have to:

- be FFA members to apply.
- live in the same county as the endorsing farmer.

Farmer Endorsements

- Students will create an endorsement request for each farmer using the farmer's name and email address during the application process.
- Endorsing farmers will receive an email containing instructions for completing the online farmer endorsement form.
- If the farmer does not have an email address, the student must print the instructions from their application and deliver them to their farmer.
- Farmers may contact the FFA Scholarship Support Team provided by ISTS, Inc. to submit their endorsement via telephone.

(Employees or family members of employees of Bayer, seed dealers and their affiliates are not eligible. See AmericasFarmers.com for additional details.)

Students – Submit online applications prior to 11:59 p.m. EST on Feb. 6, 2019**

Farmers – Submit online endorsements prior to 11:59 p.m. EST on Feb. 13, 2019**
